1.0. INVITATION TO TENDER

In line with the commitment of the Government of His Majesty Sultan Haitham bin Tarik Al Said (may Allah protect him) to enhance and diversify the national economy through the sustainable utilization of the Sultanate's natural resources, and pursuant to the Royal Directives of the late His Majesty Sultan Qaboos bin Said Al Said (may Allah rest his soul in peace), Al-Sawari International Investment Company was established as a Closed Omani Joint Stock Company. The Company's shareholders are exclusively Omani citizens from the Wilayats of Duqm and Mahout in Al Wusta Governorate.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Omani Tender Law issued by Royal Decree No. 36/2008 and in accordance with public interest requirements, Al-Sawari International Investment Company hereby invites qualified companies and establishments from the eligible Wilayats to submit their bids for the provision of tanker rental services of various categories under the CC Energy Development (CCED) Project for Blocks 3 and 4.

2.0. INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS

Tender submissions shall be made in accordance with the following requirements:

- The original Tender Document, duly stamped and signed, shall be submitted in a sealed file clearly marked with the Tender Number and Tender Title, together with all mandatory supporting documents (where applicable).
- All optional supporting documents should also be included and attached to the tender submission. Bidders are advised to carefully
- Review the instructions contained herein prior to the tender submission deadline.
- Bidders are encouraged to submit their offers well in advance of the closing date to avoid delays resulting from last-minute submissions.
- Only Local Community Contractors (LCCs) operating within the concession areas of Wilayat Mahout and Wilayat Adam are eligible to participate in this tender.
- Each company shall be eligible to be awarded a maximum of two (2) contracts covering two different tanker categories only, in order to ensure equitable distribution of contracts among participating companies and contractors. Exceptions may be made where an insufficient number of qualified bids is received.

3.0. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS:

3.1. Submission of Technical and Commercial Proposals

Technical and Commercial Proposals shall be submitted in sealed envelopes (sealed with wax) and deposited in the designated tender box located at the Company's office reception.

No submissions received after the stated deadline shall be accepted or considered.

Qualified bidders shall be contacted by call from Al-Sawari for contract execution procedures.

Contract award and execution shall take place on: **01 July 2026.**

3.1.1. Duty Working Hours: The duty schedule shall be 12 hours per day, seven (7) days per week, including normal working days, and national holidays. The daily duty hours shall be from 06:00 to 18:00. Within the 12-hour duty period, the employee shall be entitled to one (1) hour meal break (lunch), which is included in the duty hours.

3.2. Tanker Technical Criteria

3.2.1. Aging of Tanker:

- 1) All tankers shall comply with the applicable OPAL Road Safety Standards and Specifications.
- 2) The maximum allowable age of any tanker shall be 10 years from the date of manufacture.
- 3) Tankers exceeding 10 years of age shall be subject to additional technical assessment and certification prior to continued use. Such assessments may include, but are not limited to:
 - Non-Destructive Testing (NDT) inspection;
 - Hydrostatic testing (Hydro-testing);
 - Asset Integrity Assessment; and
 - Any other inspection or certification deemed necessary.

- 4) Tankers exceeding 12 years of age shall be automatically and technically disqualified from service and shall not be permitted for operation on the project.
- 5) Before any tanker maintenance involving hot work activities (e.g., welding, cutting, grinding, or similar operations), the tanker shall be thoroughly flushed, cleaned, and gas-tested. A valid gas-free certificate along with an approved Journey management Plan shall be obtained prior to mobilization to the maintenance facility or commencement of the work.

4.2 Mobilization Period and Commencement of Services

4.2.1 Mobilization Requirements

The mobilization period shall commence on the day immediately following the issuance of the Purchase Order and/or Contract Award.

All vehicles, tankers, personnel, and supporting resources shall be mobilized to the designated Project Site no later than the mentioned date and time.

The Contract Commencement Date shall be: **01 July 2026**.

All equipment shall undergo inspection by the Company's Health, Safety, Security and Environment (HSSE) Team prior to commencement of operations.

Where a vehicle successfully passes inspection, the Contractor shall be formally notified and authorized to commence work on the Contract Start Date.

Where a vehicle fails inspection, the Contractor shall rectify all deficiencies and resubmit the equipment for inspection at no additional cost to the Company.

The Contractor shall continue mobilization activities in accordance with Contract requirements and shall not be entitled to claim any additional costs, extensions, or compensation arising from inspection failures.

4.2.2 Compliance with OPAL Requirements

- The Contractor shall ensure that all vehicles, equipment, operators, and drivers are fully compliant with the requirements of the Oman Society for Petroleum Services (OPAL) and all Client-specific requirements.
- Such compliance shall be achieved within a maximum period of ten (10) calendar days from the date of Contract signature.

4.2.3 Readiness Inspection

Following Contract Award, all Prime Movers, Trailers, Tankers, Drivers, and Equipment Operators shall be subject to readiness verification and inspection by Al-Sawari International Investment Company's HSSE Supervisors.

Should the inspection reveal that the Contractor is not adequately prepared, mobilized, certified, or compliant with Contract requirements, the Company reserves the right to terminate the Contract immediately without liability or compensation.

5.0. HSE NON-COMPLIANCE PENALTIES:

The Parties agree that compliance with the Company's HSE Policies and other policies outlined under this Section is paramount and material in the execution of the Work to be provided under the Contract. If Contractor fails to comply with any or all of the Company's HSE Policies and other Company policies during the Term of this Contract, without prejudice to any other rights of the Company under this Contract or Applicable Laws, the Company shall recover from the Contractor, as a fine, a sum equal to five hundred Omani Rial (OMR 500) for each reported incident or breach. The above application of a fine for the breach of Company HSE policy and other policies shall be without prejudice to any rights or obligations under the Contract, including the right to suspend or terminate the Contract or request the replacement of Contractor Personnel.

The Company, without prejudice to any other method of recovery and without the need for judicial proceedings, may deduct or set-off the amount of fine for breach of Company HSE Policy or other policies from any due amount in its hands or which may become due to the Contractor. No prior notice shall be required for the application of fine(s) which shall become due and payable with immediate effect. The payment or deduction of such fine(s) shall not relieve the Contractor from its obligation to complete the Work or from any of its obligations and liabilities under this Contract. Contractor shall not require the payment of or transfer any or all of the fine to the Contractor Personnel who breached the Company HSE Policy or other policies under this Section, any breach of the above shall be considered a breach of the Contract. Ignorance of the Company HSE Policy or other policies will not be an excuse.
